CRAFT | LESSON 3

MY CHILD, GET UP

This week, the kids are learning that Jesus listens when they talk to him. They will each make the young girl resting in her bed to remind them of the story of Jesus raising Jairus's daughter. As they move her from awake to asleep, they will remember Jesus cares about them.

DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print out Little Girl printable and the Blanket printable.
2. Cut out the printable pieces.
 - One awake little girl, one asleep little girl per child.
 - One blanket per child.
3. Fold and then glue the left sides of the Blanket printable to create a pocket for the craft stick to fit through.
4. Gather printables and crayons for the leaders.

MAKE

1. Pass out the Little Girl and folded Blanket printables for the kids to color.
2. Help the kids tape the little girl asleep on one side of the craft stick and the little girl awake on the other side.
3. As they color and assemble, review the talking points, Bible story, and Big Idea with the kids.
4. Show the kids how the little girl can fit into the blanket and flip from asleep to awake!
5. Go over the words written on the blanket.
 - Have the kids practice saying the words aloud together!
 - Show them the girl asleep, then have them flip her awake when they say the words aloud!
