



# HEY-O JESUS

## CRAFT | LESSON 4

### JESUS ON WATER

This week, the kids are learning that Jesus' story shows them they can believe. The kids will each make their own water picture to remind them of the story of Jesus walking on water. The story sounds unbelievable, but we can always believe in Jesus and know the Bible is true!

### DIRECTIONS

#### PREP

1. Print out Jesus on Water printable on cardstock.
2. Use a white crayon to color in **only** Jesus on the printable.
3. Fill a spray bottle with water.
4. Gather printable, washable markers, spray bottle with water, and paper towels for the leaders.

#### MAKE

1. Pass out the Jesus on Water printable and markers to each kid.
2. Help the kids color their printable however they want with washable markers.
3. As the kids color, discuss the talking points, Bible story, and Big Idea.
4. Once the kids are done coloring, go around with the spray bottle and spray each craft with water, dabbing the excess water off with the paper towel.
  - The picture should be covered with different colors, leaving only Jesus without any color on him.

White crayons



Spray bottle with water



Washable markers



Paper towel roll

- Which two people walked on water in our story?
- Who in your picture is not covered in colors?
- What does it say on our Jesus picture?
- Who can we believe in and who loves us?
