



# MY FRIEND JESUS

CRAFT | LESSON 5

## PAPER PLATE FOOT WASH

This week, the children learned about the time Jesus washed the disciples' feet. Kids will use this craft to remember the Bible story and the good friend Jesus is. Children can remember that our friend Jesus shows us how to be a good friend, too.

### DIRECTIONS

#### PREP

1. Print out the Foot Washing printable.
2. Cut out the printable.
3. Gather crayons, scissors, paper, paper plate, glue, and Foot Washing printable.

#### MAKE

1. Explain to the kids that they will be making a special craft to remember today's Bible story when Jesus washed the disciples' feet.
2. Pass out the printable and allow time for kids to color and as they do, help them trace their hand, including their wrist, onto a piece of paper and cut it out.
3. After they finish coloring, have the kids glue their foot printable onto their paper plate and glue a tissue to their paper hand.
4. Help the kids stick a brad through the wrist end of their paper hand and through the printable that is glued onto their paper plate.
5. Show the kids how to move the hand side to side so it looks like it is washing feet.
6. As the kids color and create, discuss the talking points and remember the Bible story together.
  - Jesus washed the disciples' feet even though it wasn't his job.
  - A good friend does for others what Jesus does for them.
