



# MY FRIEND JESUS

CRAFT | LESSON 4

## BAPTISM CUP

This week, the children learned about Jesus' baptism. Kids will use this craft to remember the Bible story and that John the Baptist got to help with God's plan. Children can remember that when we're friends with Jesus, we get to help with God's plan, too.

## DIRECTIONS

### PREP

1. Print out the Baptism Cup printable.
2. Cut out the printable pieces.
3. Puncture a hole in the bottom of each cup that is large enough to fit a craft stick through.
4. Gather crayons, tape, craft sticks, cups, and printable pieces.

### MAKE

1. Explain to the kids that they will be making a special craft to remember Jesus' baptism.
2. Pass out the printables (1 set per child) and cups (1 per child) to the kids.
3. Allow time for kids to color the character pieces and decorate their cup to look like water.
4. As the kids color, pass out craft sticks (1 per child) and help them tape the stick to their Jesus character piece.
5. As the kids create their craft, share the following and discuss the talking points.
  - A baptism is when someone is dunked under the water because they believe in Jesus.
  - When you make the choice to be friends with Jesus because you believe and follow him, you can get baptized, too.
  - When we're friends with Jesus, we get to help with God's plan, just like John the Baptist.
6. Show the kids how to use their craft to baptize Jesus.
