## HEY PARENTS!

Today your child learned about the Bible story called Jesus Forgives Peter.  
Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's Bible story and remember the  
Big Idea: When I'm friends with Jesus, he shows me how to be a good friend!

1. What was your favorite thing you did at church today?

2. Who is the best friend we'll ever have?

Jesus!

3. Does Jesus love you when you tell a lie or make a bad choice?

Yes! He loves you no matter what!

4. Has anyone ever hurt your feelings or made you mad?

You can be a good friend like Jesus when you love your friends even when they hurt your feelings.

5. How can you be a good friend and love like Jesus did?

You can forgive your friend when they hurt your feelings, help them be brave when they are scared, make them something special to tell them you care about them, and tell them "Good job!" or "You can do it!"

6. Take some time to pray with your child. You might pray something like this:

Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus and showing us how to be a good friend.  
Thank you for loving us no matter what! Help me to love my friends no matter what, too.  
We love you! Amen.
