HEY PARENTS!

Today your child learned about the Bible story called The Transfiguration. Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's Bible story and remember the Big Idea:
When I'm friends with Jesus, he shows me how amazing he is!

1. What was your favorite thing you did at church today?

2. Who is the best friend we'll ever have?

Jesus!

3. Who were the friends Jesus chose to see his amazing change?

Peter, James, and John.

4. What happened when Jesus changed?

His face shone! He showed his friends that he was God's son!

5. Take some time to affirm the things you see in your child — the things that are true about them!

Remind them that they belong to your family, they have feelings, they are good at certain things, etc.

6. Do you know what is the MOST true thing about you?

It's the fact that God loves you and sent Jesus to die for you! That is something so amazing that you can tell your friends. Just like Jesus was his true self in front of his friends, you can be your true self in front of your friends when you tell them about how much you love Jesus.

7. Take some time to pray with your child. You might pray something like this:

Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus and showing us how to be a good friend. Thank you for loving us so much! Help me to always tell you how I feel and tell my friends about you.
