TALK IT OVER | LESSON 3

Hey parents! Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's Bible story called **Jehoshaphat** with your child after they've watched this week's Church at Home elementary video. And remember the Big Idea: *I can be royal like King Jehoshaphat when I trust God.*

1. What was your favorite part of the video we just watched?
2. When was a time you were afraid? What did you do?
3. What did King Jehoshaphat do when he was scared?
He prayed to God! Jehoshaphat told God he didn't know what to do, but he trusted God.
4. How did God take care of King Jehoshaphat?
God went before him and defeated his enemy in battle. Jehoshaphat and his army didn't need to fight.
5. What are some things you can do like King Jehoshaphat when you are scared?
You can first pray to God and tell him how you feel. You can tell him that you are scared or worried or don't know what to do, but that you still trust God. You can ask other people to pray for you, too.
6. What can you say to God when he helps you or takes care of you?
You can tell him thank you! And you don't need to wait until something happens – you thank him for what you are trusting him to do even before it happens. Jehoshaphat and his army praised God because they knew God would take care of them. When God shows you that he is taking care of you, you can pray and thank him and even sing songs of praise to him!
7. Who is the one, true king?
Jesus! You can be a part of his kingdom when you choose to love and follow him. God wants everyone to be in his family because he loves everyone so much and wants the best for his family.
This is a great time to talk to your child about their faith in Jesus.
