



Hey parents! Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's Bible story called **Solomon Asks for Wisdom** with your child after they've watched this week's Church at Home elementary video. And remember the Big Idea: *I can be royal like King Solomon when I ask God for wisdom.*

1. What was your favorite part of the video we just watched?
2. What other good king was King Solomon's dad?
King David! David and Solomon were both good kings who loved God.
3. How did God speak to Solomon?
In a dream.
4. What did King Solomon ask God for?
Wisdom. Wisdom is knowing the difference between right and wrong and doing what is right. God gave him wisdom. He was pleased with Solomon's request.
5. Why do you think wisdom is important?
Wisdom comes from God. He knows everything that is good and right. He will help you learn the right thing to do.
6. How can you ask for wisdom, too?
The Bible says, "If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you." (James 1:5a) When you have faith in God, you just need to ask God. He loves you and wants to give you good things, like wisdom, when you ask.
7. Who is the one, true king?
Jesus! You can be a part of his kingdom when you choose to love and follow him. God wants everyone to be in his family because he loves everyone so much and wants the best for his family.

This is a great time to talk to your child about their faith in Jesus.
