



Hey parents! Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's Bible story called **Esther's Request to the King** with your child after they've watched this week's Church at Home elementary video. And remember the Big Idea: *I can be royal like Queen Esther when I choose to do what is right.*

1. What was your favorite part of the video we just watched?
2. What brave thing did Queen Esther do?
She told King Xerxes about Haman's evil plan to kill the Jews. She also told the king she was also a Jew and asked him to save her people. He could have killed her because she was not allowed to ask him things like that.
3. What happened to Esther and her people?
They were saved because Esther did what was right!
4. Have you ever had to do something brave? Tell me about it.
Sometimes it's hard to be brave but making the right choice will always be best. No matter how big or small, you can choose to do the right thing and it will always matter and be big to God!
5. What are some ways you can choose to do what is right?
Being brave even if you're scared, standing up for what is right even if no one else does, trusting in God's plan even when you don't understand it, and talking to God when you feel scared or worried or you're not sure what to do. And one thing you can always do that is right is help other people!
6. Who is the one, true king?
Jesus! You can be a part of his kingdom when you choose to love and follow him. God wants everyone to be in his family because he loves everyone so much and wants the best for his family.
This is a great time to talk to your child about their faith in Jesus.
