TODDLER CRAFT | LESSON 2

LION HEADBAND

In this craft, the children will make a headband to remind them of the Bible story. They will see a lion and remember that God shut the lions' mouths so Daniel would not get hurt. Just like God and Daniel are friends, God wants to be our friend, too.

DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print out the Lion Headband printable on white cardstock.
2. Cut out headbands.
3. Have tape, crayons, paper strips, and headbands ready for the leaders.

DURING THE SERVICE

1. Pass out the Lion Headbands for the children to color.
2. Once they are done coloring, help fit the headband to each child's head. Use an extra strip of paper to add length. Tape accordingly.
3. Discuss these talking points while they color:
 - What animal is on your headband? Lion
 - What color [are you going to/did you] color your lion?
 - What sound does a lion make? Roar!
 - When lions roar, are their mouths open like this, or closed like this? They are open.
 - Who shut the lions' mouths so Daniel would not get hurt? God shut the lions' mouths.
 - Daniel was friends with God. And God wants to be your friend, too. Let's say, "God wants to be my friend."

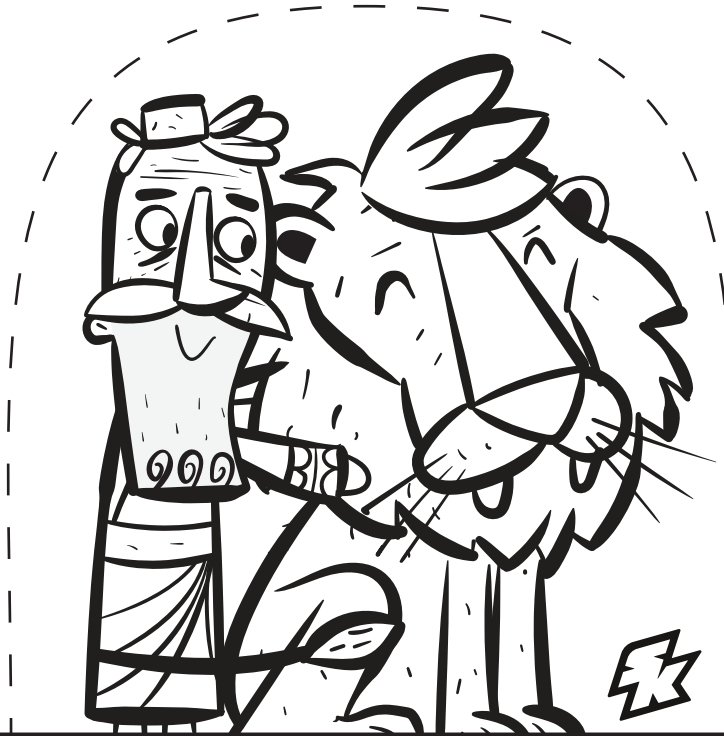
