TODDLER CRAFT | LESSON 1

DANIEL PUPPET

In this craft, the children will make a paper bag puppet of Daniel from the Bible story. This will help remind them that God wants to be our friend, just like God and Daniel are friends.

DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print out the Daniel Puppet printable on white cardstock.
2. Cut out Daniel puppet pieces (2 pieces – top and bottom half).
3. Have glue sticks, crayons, brown paper bags, and printables ready for the leaders.

DURING THE SERVICE

1. Pass out the Daniel Puppet printable for the children to color.
2. Once they are done coloring, help the children glue the top of the puppet onto the top flap of the paper bag. Help them glue the bottom half of the puppet to the bottom portion of the bag, so the top mouth piece moves when their hand is inserted.
3. While the kids make their craft, discuss the talking points:
 - *Who's face are we coloring? Daniel*
 - *Who did Daniel pray to and talk to 3 times a day? God. Let's count to 3. 1-2-3!*
 - *Daniel was friends with God. And God wants to be your friend, too! Let's say, "God wants to be my friend."*
4. This craft will be used with today's activity.

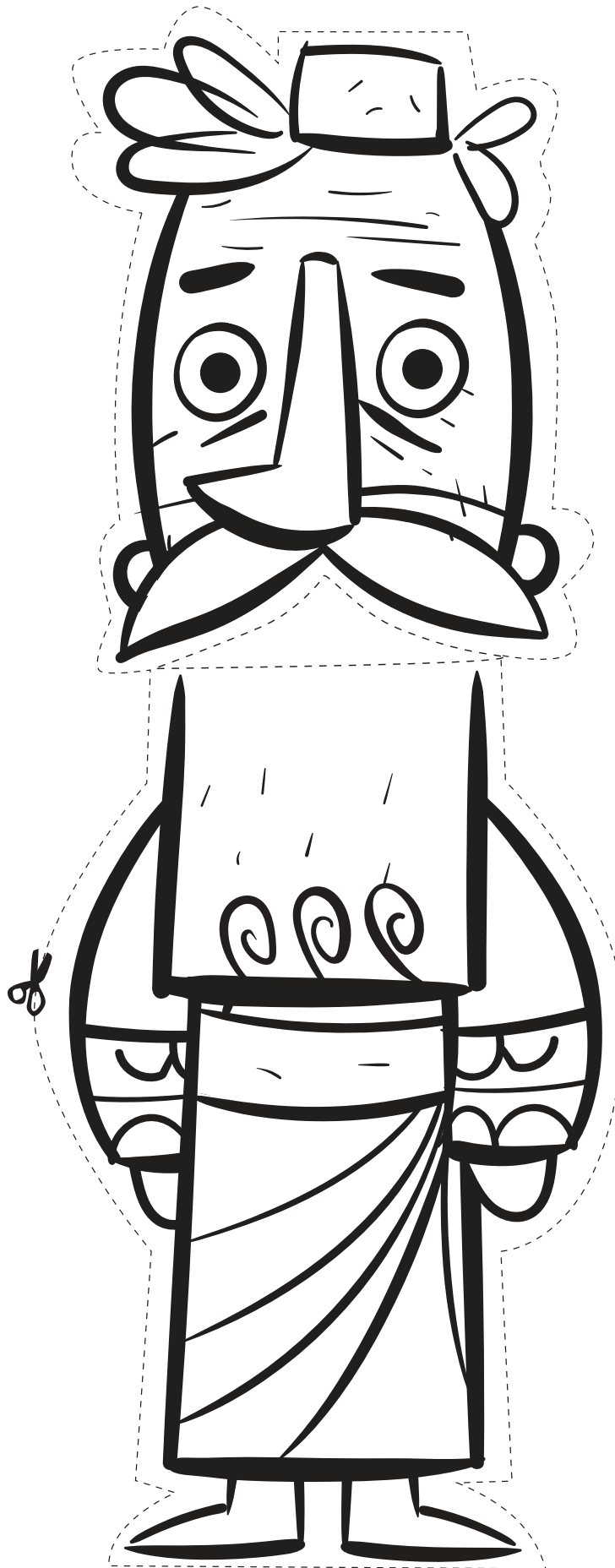
