TODDLER CRAFT | LESSON 3

DOT MARKER CROSS

In this craft, the children will make a dot marker cross. This will help remind them that Jesus died on the cross at Easter. Remind them that he did this because God loves them.



DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print out the Cross Template printable on white cardstock.
2. Tape a cross in the center of each Cross Template printable.
3. Have dot markers and printables ready for the leaders.

DURING THE SERVICE

1. Lay out dot markers in all colors on each table.
2. Pass out the Cross Template printables with taped crosses.
3. Show the children how to use the dot markers all around the taped crosses in the white space.
4. Make sure the majority of the cross outline is covered in color.
5. Once the paper is dry, remove the tape to reveal the cross.
6. While the kids make their craft, discuss the talking points:
 - Point to the cross and ask, "What is this?"
 - Who died on the cross? Jesus.
 - But Jesus came back! He is alive and okay! He did that because he loves. Point to each child and say, "Jesus loves you."
