



# GOOD SAMARITAN

TODDLER CRAFT | LESSON 2

## THE GOOD SAMARITAN BADGES

In this craft, the children will make Good Samaritan badges to remind them they can help people just like the Good Samaritan helped in the Bible story.

### DIRECTIONS

#### PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print out the Good Samaritan Badge printable on white cardstock.
2. Cut out one Good Samaritan Badge per child.
3. Cut out about 3' pieces of yarn per child.
4. Have tape, crayons, yarn, and printables ready for the leaders.

#### DURING THE SERVICE

1. Pass out the Good Samaritan Badge printables for the children to color.
2. Once they are done coloring, help the children tape the two ends of the piece of yarn to the back of the badge, making a lanyard.
3. Show the children how to wear their badges.
4. While the kids make their craft, discuss the talking points:
  - *Did everyone help the hurt Jewish man?*
  - *Your badge says, "I can be a good neighbor like the Good Samaritan." Raise your hand if you can help other people.*
  - *God loves everyone and made everyone. Can you point to someone God made?* Leader will say, *God made you, [child's name].*
