



# GOOD SAMARITAN

TODDLER ACTIVITY | LESSON 1

## TALK LIKE THE GOOD SAMARITAN

In this activity, the children will bring the craft they made to life. They will remember the main character from the Bible story known as the Good Samaritan. They will practice saying and doing things with their Samaritan craft.



## DIRECTIONS

### PREP BEFORE ACTIVITY

1. Each child makes a Good Samaritan Mask.

### DURING THE SERVICE

1. Play a game that encourages the kids to do and say things like the Good Samaritan.
2. Gather the children around in smaller groups with their leaders and say their names.
3. Next, have the kids hold up their masks to their faces and say, *I am the Good Samaritan*. Tell the children that it's time to pretend to be the Good Samaritan from today's Bible story.
4. Do and encourage the following actions with the children by saying the following:
  - A Jewish man was hurt. With your masks on, say, "I'll help!"
  - The Good Samaritan helped the man on a donkey. With your masks on, grab a pretend rope to walk the donkey!
  - Jesus said the Samaritan was a good neighbor – he was kind and helped. With your masks off, look at the Good Samaritan and say, "Good job!" or give a thumbs up.
  - Jump up and down if God made you. We can be kind to everyone God makes.
