## GOD MADE ME HANDS

In this craft, the children will make their own handprint and get the handprint of another child in class. This will help them remember that God made them and everyone in their class, too. God made everyone and he loves us all. That is why we can be like the Good Samaritan and help everyone.

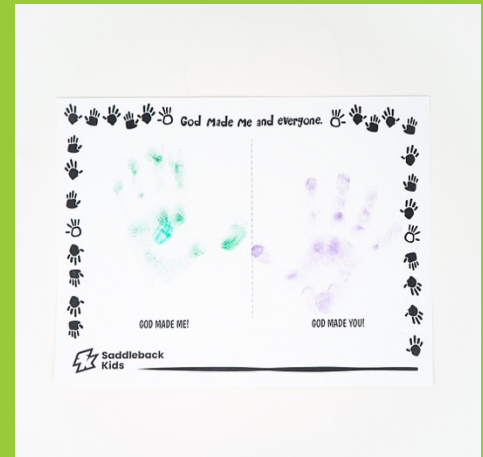
### DIRECTIONS

#### PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print out the God Made Me printable.
2. Have the stamp pads, crayons, hand wipes, and printables ready for the leaders.

#### DURING THE SERVICE

1. Pass out the God Made Me printable for the children to color.
2. Explain that they will each have two prints on their papers – one of their own and one from a friend.
3. Help each child stamp a personal handprint or fingerprint in the first box.
4. Then on another child's paper, help them stamp a personal handprint or fingerprint in the second box.
5. Each child will have their own print and another child's print on their paper.
6. While the kids make their craft, discuss the talking points:
  - *Who made you? God*
  - *Did God even make your hands? Yes*
  - *God made you and God made everyone because he loves us all!*
