TODDLER CRAFT | LESSON 3

## GOOD SAMARITAN STETHOSCOPE

In this craft, the children will make their own stethoscopes. This will help them remember that the Good Samaritan from the Bible story helped the hurting man. They can help others, too, because God made everyone.

### DIRECTIONS

#### PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print out the Stethoscope printable on white cardstock.
2. Cut out one printable piece per child.
3. Cut out about 1' pieces of ribbon per child.
4. Have tape, crayons, ribbon, headbands, and printables ready for the leaders.

#### DURING THE SERVICE

1. Pass out the Stethoscope printable for the children to color.
2. Pass out the ribbon. Help the children tape one end of the ribbon to their stethoscope printable.
3. Tape the other end of the ribbon to the center of the headband.
4. Show the children how to wear their stethoscopes and pretend to give check-ups.
5. While the kids make their craft, discuss the talking points:
  - *Stethoscopes check heartbeats. Where is your heart?*
  - *Let's pretend and make a heartbeat sound. Thump thump, thump thump, thump thump.*
  - *The Good Samaritan checked the hurt man and helped him get better.*
