



PARABLE OF THE LOST SHEEP

TODDLER CRAFT | LESSON 4

SHEPHERD SPYGLASS

In this craft, the children will create their own Shepherd Spyglass to look around to remember the story of the Lost Sheep. In the Bible story, the shepherd looked for his sheep! This will help remind them that the shepherd loved the sheep and God loves us!

DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Printout the Spyglass printable.
2. Cut out the printables into "sticker" pieces.
3. Have Spyglass printable pieces, crayons, craft rolls, tape, green paper, and glue ready for the leaders.

DURING THE SERVICE

1. Pass out a craft roll, Spyglass printable pieces, green paper, and crayons to each child.
2. Allow them to color their printables.
3. Help them tape green paper onto their craft roll.
4. Once secured, help them share glue sticks and glue the Spyglass pieces onto their spyglass.
5. Show them how to look through their spyglass. As they look around, ask the following:
 - What do you see when you look in your spyglass?
 - What animal did the shepherd see that was lost? His sheep! Baa.
 - God sees you and he loves you! Raise your hand if God loves you!

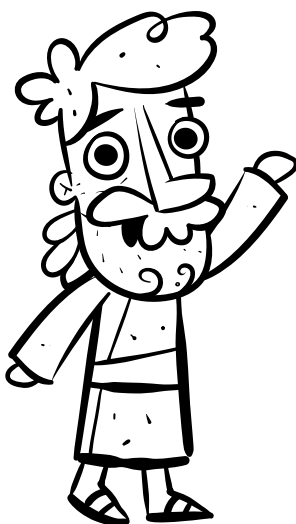

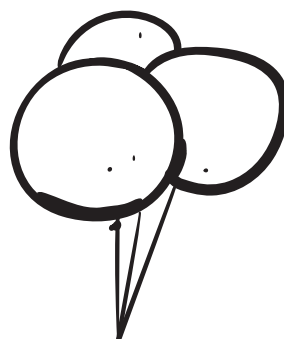
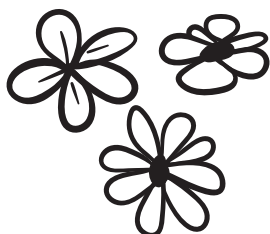
